

Surface-Safe Cleaning Checklist

CleanMol - GTA and Simcoe County 2026

Avoid the mistakes that damage surfaces

1 Never use vinegar or acids on natural stone

Acid etches granite, marble, and travertine permanently. Use a pH-neutral stone cleaner.

2 Never mix cleaning products

Bleach with ammonia or vinegar makes toxic gas. One product at a time, rinse between.

3 Keep hardwood floors barely damp

No soaking, no steam mops. Dust first, then a damp microfibre mop, and dry right away.

4 Match the pad to the surface

Soft non-scratch sponge for cooktops, tubs, and stone. Save coarse pads for sinks and cast iron.

5 Let cleaners dwell before wiping

Disinfectants and degreasers need a few minutes of contact time to actually work.

6 Use separate cloths per area

Colour-code bathroom, kitchen, and general cloths to stop spreading germs to food surfaces.
